A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING U.S. TROOPS IN SAUDI
ARABIA AND THE PERSIAN GULF; DECLARING CONTINUING SUPPORT
FOR U.S. TROOPS; MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO PROVIDE NEEDED
ITEMS TO U.S. TROOPS; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the August 2nd invasion and subsequent occupation, of Kuwait by Iraq, that have resulted in the deployment of U.S. troops to Saudi Arabia, have stirred the emotions of the American public; and

WHEREAS, concern for the brave men and women in the Armed Forces who have been sent to the Middle East dominates the thoughts of most Americans; and

WHEREAS, the pride that all Americans feel for our military personnel should be expressed so that they know they are not forgotten.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the State of Oklahoma hereby commends U.S. troops in Saudi Arabia and the Persian Gulf, recognizes the hardships they must endure, and declares continuing support for their efforts.

THAT Congress is hereby memorialized to provide to U.S. troops all that is necessary for them to fulfill their mission.

THAT copies of this resolution be dispatched to the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation, to the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives and to the Secretary of the United States Senate.
