WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Association for the Education of Young children, the Oklahoma Association of Community Action Agencies and other local organizations are celebrating the Week of the Young Child; and

WHEREAS, by calling attention to the need for quality child care for all young children within the State of Oklahoma, these groups hope to improve the quality and availability of such services; and

WHEREAS, the work of early childhood professionals is important work and the people of the State of Oklahoma deserve to be made aware of the gravity of the problems these individuals help alleviate; and

WHEREAS, quality child care services can provide a solid basis for healthy growth and development of children; and

WHEREAS, our children are the future of this great state, as well as the United States of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the week of April 6-13, 1991, is hereby declared "The Week of the Young Child" in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT each citizen of the State of Oklahoma is hereby urged to recognize the valuable contributions of early childhood teachers and care-givers and to actively support the need for more and better child care for our children.
