A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SPEEDY RETURN OF  
OKLAHOMA RESERVISTS AND NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS; AND  
DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, many units of the Oklahoma Army and Air National Guard and many Oklahoma Reserve Units of the Armed Forces were called into action during the recent Persian Gulf Crisis; and

WHEREAS, these individuals participating in Operation Desert Storm performed their tasks heroically, winning a decisive victory over a brutal tyrant; and

WHEREAS, these individuals have made great personal and financial sacrifices to fulfill their duty; and

WHEREAS, the families of Reservists and National Guard members, like the families of active military personnel, have endured hardships due to the absence of loved ones sent to the Persian Gulf; and

WHEREAS, the dedication and professionalism of the members of the National Guard and the Reserves are major reasons why the all-volunteer military force is so successful and why it has a worldwide reputation of being well trained and highly motivated; and

WHEREAS, now that the victory has been won, it is imperative that these people be returned to the United States to resume their normal lives, so that further hardships are not imposed on them or their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby respectfully requests that the President of the United States do all in his power to expedite the speedy return of Oklahoma Reservists and National Guard members to the United States.

THAT copies of this resolution be dispatched to President George Bush and to the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.
