A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DECLARING THE WEEK OF MAY 26
THROUGH JUNE 1, 1991, "PURPLE HEART WEEK".

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart is a decoration of honor awarded to members of the armed forces or to U.S. citizens honorably wounded in action; and

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart was established by George Washington in 1782 and revived in 1932; and

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart is given in recognition of noble sacrifices made in the defense of this county; and

WHEREAS, the recipient of the Purple Heart is a person of valor who has demonstrated a commitment to fighting for the ideals which have made this nation great, without regard for personal safety; and

WHEREAS, the contributions by Purple Heart recipients to the cause of freedom cannot adequately be measured and should never be forgotten; and

WHEREAS, this state is justifiably proud of the Purple Heart recipients from Oklahoma who have served this nation so valiantly and are role models for all to emulate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the week of May 26 through June 1 is hereby declared "Purple Heart Week" in Oklahoma.
