WINNING HIS FIFTH CONSECUTIVE WORLD FREESTYLE WRESTLING
TITLE; EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR THE ENJOYMENT THESE
ACCOMPLISHMENTS HAVE PROVIDED TO OKLAHOMA; AND DIRECTING
DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, Oklahoman John Smith, the 1991 World Freestyle Wrestling Champion at 138.5 pounds, has brought honor to this state by his phenomenal victories at the World Freestyle Wrestling Championships held in Varna, Bulgaria; and

WHEREAS, John Smith has achieved an unsurpassed standard of excellence in the sport of wrestling during his career as a wrestler at Del City High School and Oklahoma State University; and

WHEREAS, John Smith's numerous wrestling triumphs, in addition to the 1991 World Freestyle Wrestling Championship, include the World Freestyle Wrestling Championship title in 1987, 1989, and 1990; being a Gold Medalist at the XXIV Summer Olympic Games in Seoul, South Korea; two NCAA titles; championships in the Pan American Games and the U.S. Olympic Festival; the James E. Sullivan Award for the nation's outstanding amateur athlete, as voted on by the media; and being chosen the United States Olympic Committee's 1991 Athlete of the Year, as voted on by his peers; and

WHEREAS, John Smith has won five consecutive world championships and is the only five-time champion in U.S. history; and

WHEREAS, through diligence and hard work, this remarkable young man has gained worldwide recognition and success, and is considered to be the best amateur wrestler in the world.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature, on behalf of the people of the State of Oklahoma, hereby extends sincere congratulations to John Smith for his outstanding accomplishments in the sport of wrestling, particularly winning his fifth consecutive World Freestyle Wrestling Championship at 138.5 pounds in the 1991 World Freestyle Wrestling Championships in Varna, Bulgaria, and expresses great pride in his many achievements and his contributions to the sport of wrestling.
