A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF
NORTHEAST 23RD STREET, ALSO KNOWN AS U.S. HIGHWAY 62, AS
"THE JOHN MISKELLY, JR. MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; AND DIRECTING
DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature has had many illustrious members during its history and it is fitting that recognition be given to former members of the Legislature who provided leadership to said body; and

WHEREAS, the late John Miskelly, Jr. served with distinction in the House of Representatives from 1965 through 1977; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, John Miskelly, Jr. served as Vice Chairman of the Appropriations and Budget Committee from 1966-1973, Chairman of the Appropriations and Budget Committee from 1973-1977, and was chosen as delegation leader by the Oklahoma County Democrat House members in 1969; and

WHEREAS, John Miskelly, Jr. was a dynamic legislator who worked tirelessly for the betterment of the state; and

WHEREAS, John Miskelly, Jr. served this country as a member of the United States Marine Corps and was actively involved in many civic organizations and projects; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Northeast 23rd Street, also known as U.S. Highway 62, from the junction of Interstate 35 east to the vicinity of Harrah, was built primarily due to the outstanding efforts of John Miskelly, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Legislature to show respect for this outstanding former legislator by designating the John Miskelly, Jr. Memorial Highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the portion of Northeast 23rd Street, also known as U.S. Highway 62, from Anderson Road to Harrah Road be designated "The John Miskelly, Jr. Memorial Highway" as a lasting testimonial to the leadership and industry of former Representative John Miskelly, Jr. in achieving, among other things, the construction of said highway.

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed at appropriate sites upon Northeast 23rd Street, also known as U.S. Highway 62, bearing the name "The John Miskelly, Jr. Memorial Highway".

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the family of John Miskelly, Jr., to members of the Oklahoma Transportation Commission, and to the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.
