A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE AMERICAN WORKER;
MEMORIALIZING GOVERNOR DAVID WALTERS TO PROCLAIM LABOR DAY,
SEPTEMBER 7, 1992, AS "HELP YOURSELF, BUY AMERICAN DAY";
ENCOURAGING OKLAHOMANS TO PAY TRIBUTE TO THE AMERICAN
WORKER BY PURCHASING AMERICAN-MADE PRODUCTS AND
MERCHANDISE; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the current recession facing Oklahoma and the rest of the United States of America has been costly to the American people in terms of jobs and economic stress; and

WHEREAS, companies owned and operated by Americans are manufacturing superior merchandise at competitive prices with heightened productivity; and

WHEREAS, the economy in the United States is stimulated, creating increased employment opportunities and economic growth, when consumers purchase products made in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the plight of jobless workers in America is due in part to American consumers not recognizing a need to purchase quality merchandise produced in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, Oklahomans and other Americans can help reinvigorate their economies by purchasing quality products and merchandise made by the American Worker; and

WHEREAS, Section 51 of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Section 90.6 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes require agencies of the state government of Oklahoma to purchase goods, equipment and beef produced in the United States of America, except under certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the President and Congress of the United States have been actively working to expand manufacturing in this country by encouraging the purchase of American-made products; and

WHEREAS, each state can and should play an important role in promoting this effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature memorializes Governor David Walters to proclaim that Labor Day, September 7, 1992, be officially declared "Help Yourself, Buy American Day" in Oklahoma and that Oklahomans pay tribute to the American Worker on that day and on all subsequent days by making a conscious effort to purchase American-made products and merchandise.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Governor David Walters.
