A JOINT RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE INSTALLATION OF A
HIGHWAY INFORMATIONAL SIGN FOR THE JASMINE MORAN FOUNDATION
CHILDREN'S MUSEUM; AND PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the Jasmine Moran Foundation Children's Museum is a
children's museum located in Seminole; and

WHEREAS, the museum was established for educational purposes for
young children and meant for the public good and welfare of people
of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the museum is located off the interstate highway system
and it is necessary to advertise the location of the museum to
prospective visitors who travel the interstate highway system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to advertise the museum by way of an
informational sign along I-40 at or near the Highway 377 junction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Jasmine Moran Foundation Children's Museum may
erect and install informational signs at or near the junction of I-
40 and Highway 377.

SECTION 2. The informational signs shall be erected and
installed in accordance with the Highway Advertising Control Act of
1972 and any or all other laws or guidelines with regard to highway
signs.

SECTION 3. Copies of this resolution shall be distributed to
the Jasmine Moran Foundation Children's Museum, and the Department
of Transportation.
