A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND PRAISING THE OKLAHOMA CITY UNIVERSITY CHIEFS MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM FOR CAPTURING THE 1991 NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, Oklahoma City University has long been a leader in the athletic arena as well as in the academic community; and

WHEREAS, one of that proud university's longest traditions is that of basketball excellence; and

WHEREAS, in the first year of Head Coach Darrell Johnson, a new, prominent chapter was added to that tradition of excellence; and

WHEREAS, on Monday, March 18, 1991, at Kansas City's Kemper Arena, the Oklahoma City University Chiefs Men's Basketball Team convincingly won the 1991 NAIA Basketball Championship before a national television audience on ESPN, winning their fifth game in six days; and

WHEREAS, in route to this impressive achievement, the Oklahoma City University Chiefs compiled an amazing 35-3 record, including 16 straight victories, the NAIA District Nine Championship, the Wild, Wild West Classic Championship, and the Bud Light Incarnate World Classic Championship; and

WHEREAS, Darrell Johnson was honored for his astonishing performance as first year coach of the Chiefs with the NAIA District Nine Coach of the Year award; and
