A RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENT OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITH REGARD TO PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITIES; DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, safe and affordable public housing has been a valuable asset to the well-being of America's elderly citizens for many years; and

WHEREAS, public housing for the elderly is now threatened by an increase in urban violence; and

WHEREAS, this rise in violence has caused the elderly to live in fear and isolation; and

WHEREAS, all Americans bear the moral responsibility of protecting the elderly from violent crimes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT all public housing authorities in the State of Oklahoma provide separate or secure housing for elderly and handicapped residents to protect them from persons involved in criminal and hazardous activities.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to all public housing authorities in the State of Oklahoma.
