A RESOLUTION EXTENDING CONGRATULATIONS TO DR. GEORGE HUMPHREYS FOR RECEIVING THE 1992 OKLAHOMA BOOK AWARD FOR BEST NONFICTION BOOK OF THE YEAR; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Book Awards, now in their third year, were initiated by the Oklahoma Center for the Book which is in the Oklahoma Department of Libraries and is an affiliate of the Library of Congress; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Oklahoma Book Awards is to recognize Oklahoma's literary achievements, stimulate public interest in books and reading, foster appreciation of national and local literary heritage and promote literacy; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Book Awards are given annually for books which have an Oklahoma-based theme or have been written by an author who has resided in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the 1992 Oklahoma Book Awards attracted more than 120 entries for this year's competition; and
