RESOLUTION NO. 1041 BY: BOYD

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE REVEREND DR. WARREN C. HULTGREN; RECOGNIZING HIS WORK AND CONTRIBUTIONS; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren has ministered to his congregation at the First Baptist Church in Tulsa for thirty-five years; and

WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren brought to the First Baptist Church in Tulsa and the State of Oklahoma a rich personal history from a youth spent in Minnesota where he was raised in the Presbyterian Church, his college years in Texas at Hardin Simmons University and Southwestern Baptist Seminary where he was drawn to the ministry in the Southern Baptist Convention, his experiences as a youth evangelist in the 1940's, and his ministries in Baptist Churches in Swanson and Corpus Christi, Texas and Lake Charles, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren's ministry to those who needed his compassion will be one of the most appreciated memories of his pastorate; and

WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren's lifetime commitment to interfaith work led him to open the doors to all believers at the First Baptist Church in Tulsa, to his active participation in numerous interfaith ministries, and to preach the Gospel to persons of all ages, situations, and faiths; and

WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren was renowned both for his wonderful sense of humor and widely admired sermons; and

WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren's career at the First Baptist Church in Tulsa will be remembered for his leadership in extending that congregation's ministry, for helping to establish other Tulsa-area Baptist Churches, for baptizing over 2,800 persons into the Church, and for helping First Baptist Church in Tulsa to raise over \$11 million in mission giving.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren is recognized and commended for his outstanding spiritual and community contributions.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives expresses its best wishes to the Reverend Dr. Warren C. Hultgren as he leaves his position as the pastor at First Baptist Church in Tulsa.
