A RESOLUTION DEDICATING THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE TO THE MEMORY OF THOMAS J. MANAR; MAKING A PERMANENT RECORD; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, with the death of Representative Tom Manar on May 15, 1992, the State of Oklahoma has lost a dedicated public servant and champion of the people; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar was a man of integrity who took seriously the business of government and who strove to make government responsive to the needs of the citizens of this state; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar cared deeply for the people of his community and of this state and always exerted extra effort on their behalf; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar always stood firm in his convictions and never shirked any duty or responsibility or avoided controversial issues that needed to be addressed; and

WHEREAS, Tom Manar provided leadership and guidance to the Legislature and thereby helped shape the future of this state; and

WHEREAS, no one can adequately assess the value of Tom Manar's endeavors on behalf of Oklahoma, but it is certain that this state has suffered a great loss because of the death of Tom Manar, and that it will be impossible to fill the void left by his death.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the 2nd Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature is hereby dedicated to the memory of Thomas J. Manar.
