AN ACT RELATING TO PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS;  
AMENDING SECTION 4, CHAPTER 185, O.S.L. 1985 (59  
O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 61.4), WHICH RELATES TO  
THE STATE BARBER ADVISORY BOARD; RE-CREATING THE  
STATE BARBER ADVISORY BOARD; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 185, O.S.L.  
1985 (59 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 61.4), is amended to read as  
follows:

Section 61.4 The State Barber Advisory Board is hereby created  
until July 1, ~~1991~~ 1997, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law,  
Section 3901 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which  
shall consist of five (5) members consisting of four barbers and one  
lay member. Each member of the State Barber Advisory Board shall be  
appointed by the Governor and serve at the pleasure of the Governor  
for a term coterminous with that of the Governor. Provided, each  
member may continue to serve after the expiration of the member's  
term until such time as a successor is appointed. The State Barber  
Advisory Board shall advise the State Board of Health concerning  
regulations and shall advise and assist the State Department of  
Health in administering this act and the examinations.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
