AN ACT RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; AMENDING 74  
O.S. 1981, SECTION 4216, AS LAST AMENDED BY  
SECTION 19, CHAPTER 303, O.S.L. 1988 (74 O.S.  
SUPP. 1990, SECTION 4216), WHICH RELATES TO  
MAXIMUM CONTRIBUTIONS; PROVIDING LIMIT ON  
CONTRIBUTIONS TO CERTAIN LOCAL CANDIDATES; AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1981, Section 4216, as  
last amended by Section 19, Chapter 303, O.S.L. 1988 (74 O.S. Supp.  
1990, Section 4216), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4216. No person or family may contribute more than Five  
Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to a political party or organization in  
any calendar year. No person or family may contribute more than  
Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to a candidate for state office or  
to a candidate for municipal office in a municipality with a  
population of over two hundred fifty thousand (250,000) persons,  
according to the most recent federal decennial census, or to a  
candidate for a county office or to an organization authorized by  
such a candidate to receive contributions or make expenditures on  
his behalf, nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to a  
candidate for other local office or to an organization authorized by  
such a candidate to receive contributions or make expenditures on  
his behalf for a campaign. No political party, organization or  
candidate shall receive contributions in excess of the amounts  
provided herein.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
