AN ACT RELATING TO ROADS, BRIDGES AND FERRIES;
AMENDING 69 O.S. 1991, SECTION 1277, WHICH
RELATES TO THE HIGHWAY ADVERTISING CONTROL ACT
OF 1968; PROHIBITING DENIAL OR REVOCATION OF
CERTAIN PERMITS WITHOUT COMPLIANCE WITH
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 1991, Section 1277, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1277. A. The Transportation Commission is hereby
authorized to enact and adopt rules and regulations for the issuance
of licenses and permits and the charging and collection of permit
fees for other than "on-premise" outdoor advertising structures as
defined in this act.

B. No permit application shall be denied or existing permit
revoked without first giving the applicant or existing permit owner
notice of denial or revocation and an opportunity to be heard in
accordance with the provisions of Article II of the Administrative
Procedures Act, Section 309 et seq. of Title 75 of the Oklahoma
Statutes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
