AN ACT RELATING TO FUNDS FOR STATE AGENCIES; AMENDING
SECTION 45 OF ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 2425 OF THE
2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, WHICH
RELATES TO AN APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE
ATTORNEY GENERAL, AND SECTION 21 OF ENROLLED HOUSE
BILL NO. 2227 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD
OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, WHICH RELATES TO THE
CORPORATION COMMISSION; REDUCING APPROPRIATION;
MODIFYING PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; MODIFYING
SOURCE OF MONIES TO BE DEPOSITED IN CERTAIN FUND;
REPEALING SECTION 27 OF ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO.
1977 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA
LEGISLATURE, WHICH RELATES TO AN APPROPRIATION TO
THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 45 of Enrolled House Bill
No. 2425 of the 2nd Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 45. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1993, the sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars
(\$70,000.00) or so much thereof as may be required for the Workers'
Compensation Fraud Unit or to match or replace federal funds.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 21 of Enrolled House Bill
No. 2227 of the 2nd Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 21. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Corporation Commission, to be designated the "Oil and Gas Division Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies designated for deposit to said fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and shall be expended by the Corporation Commission for the purposes of expeditious prevention and abatement of oil and gas pollution, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment. No money shall be transferred or expended by the Corporation Commission for any other purpose than that authorized by this section.

SECTION 3. REPEALER Section 27 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1977 of the 2nd Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1992.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
