AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO AGRICULTURE; AMENDING 2 O.S. 1981,
SECTION 5-5, WHICH RELATES TO AGRICULTURAL
MARKETING; CLARIFYING STATUTORY LANGUAGE; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 1981, Section 5-5, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-5. The Board shall have authority to promulgate, pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, the rules and regulations necessary for carrying out all provisions of this subarticle title relating to agricultural marketing, and to make investigations, and hold hearings for the purpose of making inspection compulsory on any farm product, when it believes that the best interests of the shippers or the public will be served thereby. The Board shall designate the shipping points at which such compulsory inspection shall apply.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
