AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS; AUTHORIZING THE
COMMISSIONERS OF THE LAND OFFICE TO LEASE CERTAIN
LANDS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 261.1 of Title 64, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Commissioners of the Land Office may lease any of the school
or other lands owned by the State of Oklahoma which the
Commissioners may deem valuable and profitable to cooperative
agricultural associations, cooperative corporations, or cooperative
marketing associations for the purpose of livestock production
systems. Such leases shall be in compliance with the provisions of
Sections 241 through 260.2 of Title 64 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
