AN ACT RELATING TO VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES; MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE APPELLATE PUBLIC DEFENDER;
STATING THE PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND
COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING BUDGETARY
LIMITATIONS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE
OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; STATING THE PURPOSE;
PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES;
PROVIDING BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS; PROVIDING A
LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE DATE; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

APPELLATE PUBLIC DEFENDER SYSTEM

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
Appellate Public Defender System from any monies not otherwise
appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of _____
Dollars (\$_____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to

perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Appellate Public Defender System by law.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Appellate Public Defender System by law shall be set by the Appellate Public Defender. The Oklahoma Appellate Public Defender System for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of _____ Dollars (\$_____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the

Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal year ending July 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
