AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUORS; AMENDING 37

O.S. 1981, SECTION 502, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2,
CHAPTER 6, O.S.L. 1985 (37 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION
502), WHICH RELATES TO THE OKLAHOMA ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGE CONTROL ACT; MODIFYING SHORT TITLE;
REQUIRING WHOLESALERS TO FILE CERTAIN REPORTS;
PROVIDING CONTENTS OF REPORTS; PROHIBITING CHANGING
OF PRICES FOR CERTAIN PERIOD OF TIME; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37 O.S. 1981, Section 502, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 6, O.S.L. 1985 (37 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 502), is amended to read as follows:

Section 502. ~~Sections 2 through 105 of this act and Sections 504, 516, 533, 543.1, 562 and 566~~ Section 501 et seq. of this title shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 600 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each licensed wholesaler shall file a report with the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission stating the price which the wholesaler shall charge for each individual item or size of item which the wholesaler proposes to offer for sale for a two-month period beginning with the first day of the month following the filing of the report. The report shall be filed on or before the fifteenth day of January, March, May, July, September and November. The report shall describe each item by brand, size, age, type and proof, and in the case of wines and sparkling wines, the alcoholic content. No price adjustments shall be allowed for any period for which a report is filed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
