AN ACT RELATING TO COUNTIES AND COUNTY OFFICERS;

AMENDING SECTION 1, CHAPTER 291, O.S.L. 1982 (19
O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 215.29), WHICH RELATES TO
DISTRICT ATTORNEYS BEARING FIREARMS; AUTHORIZING
ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS TO BEAR FIREARMS;
AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF SUCH RIGHT; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 291, O.S.L.
1982 (19 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 215.29), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 215.29 A district attorney and any assistant district attorney may carry a firearm on ~~his~~ the person or in the motor vehicle of such district attorney or assistant district attorney to use only for personal protection if ~~he~~ such person has successfully completed an approved course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Such person may retain the right to keep and bear firearms as provided for in this section upon retirement or the leaving of active service as a district attorney or assistant district attorney.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
