AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING SECTION

5, CHAPTER 80, O.S.L. 1986 (47 O.S. SUPP. 1990,

SECTION 230.5), WHICH RELATES TO THE OKLAHOMA MOTOR

CARRIER SAFETY AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

TRANSPORTATION ACT; CLARIFYING STATUTORY LANGUAGE;

AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 80, O.S.L. 1986 (47 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 230.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 230.5 Motor carriers and other persons subject to the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials Transportation Act shall make available to the Department of Public Safety or officer, employee or agent thereof including but not limited to members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol for inspection and copying their accounts, books, records, memoranda, correspondence, and other documents, ~~and~~. In addition, such motor carriers and other persons subject to the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials Transportation Act shall allow their lands, buildings and equipment to be examined and inspected by any officer, employee, or agent of

the Department of Public Safety, including but not limited to members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, upon demand and display of the credentials issued by the Commissioner.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
