AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO EMINENT DOMAIN; LIMITING THE RIGHT
OF EMINENT DOMAIN OF CERTAIN STATE ENTITIES;
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5.1 of Title 27, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except as otherwise specifically authorized by the Legislature,
no department, board, commission, institution or agency of this
state shall have the right of eminent domain for recreational,
tourism or wildlife purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
