AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CITIES AND TOWNS; AMENDING 11 O.S.

1981, SECTION 37-110, WHICH RELATES TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WATER DISTRICTS; LIMITING AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH SUCH DISTRICTS TO CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES; PROVIDING FOR DISTRICTS TO BE CREATED FOR OTHER PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SOURCES; AUTHORIZING CREATION OF DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF A MUNICIPALITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1981, Section 37-110, is amended to read as follows:

Section 37-110. The governing body of any municipality, with a population of forty-five thousand (45,000) or more, securing its water supply from a stream ~~or,~~ reservoir or other public water supply source located inside or outside of its corporate limits may designate by ordinance a district to be known as a water district. The water district shall be designated by metes and bounds and may embrace any lands, directly or indirectly flowing or shedding water into any such stream ~~or,~~ reservoir or other public water supply source as the governing body ordains. The governing body may enforce any rules and regulations made by the State Commissioner of

Health, the county superintendent of public health, or the municipal public health officer for the protection of any such water supply.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
