AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO COUNTIES AND COUNTY OFFICERS;

PROVIDING FOR THE DISPENSING OF THE NUMERICAL INDEX

OF DEEDS IN EACH COUNTY UNDER CERTAIN

CIRCUMSTANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 291.1 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Every county clerk in each county of this state, upon automation of an alphabetical grantor-grantee index system in the county, may, at his or her discretion, dispense with the numerical index of deeds provided for in Section 291 of this title. In order for the grantor-grantee index to be considered automated, it must be maintained in a suitable computer environment. Terminals shall be available to the public and provisions made to allow computer back-up of the data base. In any county where the grantor-grantee index system has been automated, if the county clerk elects to dispense with the numerical index, he or she must make available to the

public the numerical index which shall include entries to the first entry in the automated grantor-grantee index system.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
