AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CITIES AND TOWNS; AMENDING 11 O.S.
1991, SECTION 21-121, WHICH RELATES TO CERTAIN
ELECTRIC SYSTEMS; PROHIBITING CERTAIN ENTITIES FROM
FURNISHING ELECTRIC SERVICE UNDER CERTAIN
CIRCUMSTANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1991, Section 21-121, is amended to read as follows:

Section 21-121. Except as provided in this section, or as provided in subsection (k) of Section 437.2 of Title 18 of the Oklahoma Statutes, municipal corporations or public trusts thereof, or rural electric cooperatives shall not ~~acquire, through any means,~~ ~~a customer of or any part of any system belonging to or being served~~ furnish retail electric service to a premise or a consumer which is being served or in which electric facilities are in place to render such a service by a municipal corporation or public trust thereof or a rural electric cooperative, unless the majority of the governing boards of the entities involved have agreed by mutual consent, in writing, to such transaction.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
