AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO ROADS, BRIDGES AND FERRIES;

EXEMPTING CERTAIN OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES FROM

TURNPIKE TOLLS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND

PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1711.1 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Every owner of a motor vehicle who resides in Tulsa County and who is issued a certificate of registration and license plate or yearly decal for the motor vehicle, as provided in Section 1113 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, in Tulsa County shall be exempt from paying tolls for the use of any turnpike located in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1992.
