A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND PRAISING STATE REPRESENTATIVE LARRY GISH OF STILLWATER; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, a special member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives has made such a choice and fulfills that commitment to the people he represents; and

WHEREAS, Representative Larry Gish has perpetuated the notion of hard work, dedication and compassion that has been his hallmark since his early days as an assistant city manager.
