A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
CORRECTIONS TO WITHHOLD CERTAIN MONEYS FOR COSTS OF
INCARCERATION; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, inmates of state correctional institutions who qualify for sales tax relief pursuant to the Sales Tax Relief Act, may file claims for relief and receive payment from the Oklahoma Tax Commission in the amounts specified in Section 5011 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 549 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes authorizes the State Board of Corrections to charge inmates for costs of incarceration, if said charge does not exceed fifty percent of the deposits made to an inmate's income account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Department of Corrections withhold up to fifty percent of any money inmates receive for claims made pursuant to the Sales Tax Relief Act for costs of incarceration.

THAT copies of this resolution be dispatched to the members of the State Board of Corrections and to the Director of Corrections.
