AS INTRODUCED

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION THANKING PERSONS WHO HAVE SERVED ON THE STATE ETHICS COMMISSION OR THE OKLAHOMA COUNCIL ON CAMPAIGN COMPLIANCE AND ETHICAL STANDARDS; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Ethics Commission, which became in 1988 the Oklahoma Council on Campaign Compliance and Ethical Standards, was created by the Legislature by enactment of House Bill 2054 in 1986; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the independent State Ethics Commission represented a major reform designed to insure the integrity of Oklahoma election campaigns and to improve the level of trust Oklahoma citizens would have in their elected officials and public employees; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma has benefitted by the quality of those outstanding individuals who have served or are serving on the State Ethics Commission or the Oklahoma Council on Campaign Compliance and Ethical Standards; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Council on Campaign Compliance and Ethical Standards will be replaced July 1, 1991 by the Ethics Commission; and

WHEREAS, the new Ethics Commission will be charged with upholding the high standards established by those who have served on the Oklahoma Ethics Commission and the Oklahoma Council on Campaign Compliance and Ethical Standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature, on behalf of the citizens of Oklahoma, extends its thanks to the members who have served or are serving on the Oklahoma Ethics Commission or the Oklahoma Council on Campaign Compliance and Ethical Standards for their dedicated service to the State of Oklahoma.
