AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE OKLAHOMA CENTER FOR THE
ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY; MAKING
APPROPRIATIONS THERETO; STATING PURPOSES; PROVIDING
FOR THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES;
LIMITING THE SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT OR ACTING
PRESIDENT OF THE CENTER; PROVIDING BUDGETARY
LIMITATIONS; REQUIRING THE BUDGET WORK PROGRAM TO
INCLUDE CERTAIN BUDGET ENTITIES AND ACTIVITIES;
PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE DATE;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the following amount for deposit in the Research Support Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 5060.11 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

Applied Research	\$2,750,000.00
Health Research	1,334,613.00
Technology Transfer	<u>60,000.00</u>
Total	\$4,144,613.00

None of the monies appropriated in this section may be used for salary or fringe benefits for employees of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology included in the budgetary limitation provided in Section 3 of this act.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Nine Hundred Eighty-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$987,780.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of funding personal services costs and administrative and data processing functions of the agency. Said appropriation shall be transferred to the Administration and Data Processing Revolving Fund for expenditure in accordance with the provisions of Section 5060.24 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology by law shall be set by the President. The salary of the President or Acting President shall not exceed Fifty-eight Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$58,100.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 41.7 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology shall file its budget work program with the Director of State Finance and the Legislative Service Bureau for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, to include the following budget entities and activities:

- Administration
- Centers of Excellence
- Applied Research
- MOST Research Equipment
- Health Research
- Technology Transfer
- Seed-Capital Financing

SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
