AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE OKLAHOMA STATE REGENTS FOR
HIGHER EDUCATION; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THERETO;
STATING PURPOSE; PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN
OPERATIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Five Hundred Thirty-six Million Three Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$536,378,867.00) for allocation pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to the institutions in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repair administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise

appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for allocation pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) for transfer to the Oklahoma State Regents' Endowment Trust Fund.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Three Million Five Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$3,527,247.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the general operating budget of the Administrative Offices of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the general operating budget of the Administrative Offices of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Twelve Million Two Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars

(\$12,282,967.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grants.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Five Million Five Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Dollars (\$5,532,000.00) for transfer to the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars Trust Fund.

SECTION 8. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 9. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
