AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR; MAKING
APPROPRIATIONS THERETO; STATING PURPOSES; PROVIDING
FOR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING
BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS; AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF
CERTAIN PERSONS CONTINGENT UPON PROCUREMENT OF
FEDERAL FUNDS; PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN
OPERATIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Two Million Thirty-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-one Dollars (\$2,037,731.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Labor by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Occupational Health and Safety Fund of the State Treasury for the

fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of One Million One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$1,140,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Labor by law.

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Labor by law shall be set by the Commissioner of Labor. The Department of Labor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. Of the one hundred ten (110) full-time-equivalent employee positions authorized in Section 3 of this act, twenty (20) full-time-equivalent employee positions shall be filled contingent upon the procurement of federal funds. Said twenty (20) full-time-equivalent employee positions supported by federal funds shall be terminated when federal support of those positions is discontinued.

SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
