AN ACT RELATING TO VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES; MAKING  
APPROPRIATIONS THERETO; STATING PURPOSES; MAKING  
APPROPRIATIONS NONFISCAL; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Public Affairs from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Fifty-eight Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$3,858,335.00) and from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the repair, renovation and maintenance of state facilities.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital

Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the economic development programs designed to enhance the state's capacity for a diversified and expanding economy.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Nine Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$100,916.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase of equipment.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Public Affairs from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for mail sorting equipment.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for construction, renovation and equipping of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the State Emergency Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00). Said appropriation shall be expended in conformity

with the provisions of Section 139.42 et seq. of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expansion of prison space in the form of community work centers and/or drug offender work camps.

SECTION 8. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) to be transferred to the Statewide Water Development Revolving Fund established by Section 9, Chapter 306, O.S.L. 1982 (82 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 1085.40) and shall be expended in accordance with the provisions set forth therein.

SECTION 9. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
