AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOLS; AMENDING 70 O.S. 1981,  
SECTION 5-123, AS LAST AMENDED BY SECTION 16,  
CHAPTER 300, O.S.L. 1989 (70 O.S. SUPP. 1990,  
SECTION 5-123), WHICH RELATES TO SCHOOL DISTRICT  
EXPENDITURE LIMITATIONS; CHANGING CERTAIN LIMIT;  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1981, Section 5-123, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter 300, O.S.L. 1989 (70 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 5-123), is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-123. No expenditure involving an amount greater than ~~Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)~~ Four Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$490.00) shall be made by a board of education except in accordance with the provisions of a written contract or purchase order, and no contract involving an expenditure of more than Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) for the purpose of erecting any public building or making any improvements shall be made except upon sealed proposals and to the lowest responsible bidder. Provided, this

section shall not be construed to prohibit a school district from erecting a building or making improvements on a force account basis. Contracts with any state agency for the purpose of emergency asbestos abatement shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
