AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING 47 O.S. 1981, SECTION 15-104, WHICH RELATES TO A SIGN MANUAL FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES; STIPULATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC GUIDE DEVICES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY MUST CONFORM TO STATE MANUAL; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1981, Section 15-104, is amended to read as follows:

Section 15-104. A. The ~~State Highway~~ Transportation Commission shall adopt a manual and specifications for a uniform system of traffic-control devices for use upon streets and highways within this state. Such uniform system shall correlate with and, so far as possible, conform to the system then current as approved by the American Association of State Highway Officials, and the manual so adopted may be amended or revised from time to time as the Commission may deem necessary. The manual so adopted and any amendments or revisions thereof shall be published by the ~~State Highway~~ Transportation Commission and one copy thereof shall be distributed free of charge to the local governing bodies of counties and incorporated cities and towns.

B. No person shall install or maintain in any area of private property used by the public any sign, signal, marking or other device intended to regulate, warn or guide traffic unless it conforms with the state manual and specifications.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
