AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CHILDREN; AMENDING 10 O.S. 1981,
SECTION 175.2, WHICH RELATES TO CRIPPLED CHILDREN;
TRANSFERRING CERTAIN PROPERTIES, RECORDS, EQUIPMENT
AND SUPPLIES TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 1981, Section 175.2, is amended to read as follows:

Section 175.2 (a) All properties, records, equipment and supplies now owned and in use by the Oklahoma Commission for crippled children shall be transferred to and become the property of the State Department of ~~Public Welfare~~ Health.

(b) All written bona fide contracts, leases and such other written agreements as may have been entered into by the Oklahoma Commission for crippled children and such responsibilities as are in effect on the effective date of this act, including the provisions and the payment of per diem to the Oklahoma Spastic Paralysis Commission, as provided in 63 O.S. 1951, Section 485.3, shall be assumed by and become binding upon the ~~Oklahoma Public Welfare Commission~~ State Board of Health and the State Department of ~~Public Welfare~~ Health.

(c) All unexpended funds to the credit of the Oklahoma Commission for Crippled Children shall be transferred by the State

Treasurer to the State Department of ~~Public Welfare~~ Health and placed in a separate account with said State Treasurer, the account to be known as the "State's Crippled Children's Fund".

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
