AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CRIMES AND PUNISHMENTS; AMENDING
21 O.S. 1981, SECTION 1483, WHICH RELATES TO
EXTORTION; MODIFYING LANGUAGE; INCLUDING ATTEMPTED
EXTORTION AS A CRIME; REPEALING 21 O.S. 1981,
SECTION 1487, WHICH RELATES TO ATTEMPTED EXTORTION;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1981, Section 1483, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1483. Every person who extorts or attempts to extort any money or other property from another, under circumstances not amounting to robbery, by means of force or any threat such as is mentioned in ~~the last section~~ Section 1482 of this title, is punishable by imprisonment in the ~~penitentiary~~ State Penitentiary not exceeding five (5) years.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 21 O.S. 1981, Section 1487, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
