AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CRIMES AND PUNISHMENTS; AMENDING  
21 O.S. 1981, SECTION 7, WHICH RELATES TO OBJECTS  
OF PENAL CODE; CLARIFYING REFERENCE; AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1981, Section 7, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 7. This ~~chapter~~ title specifies the classes of persons  
who are deemed capable of crimes, and liable to punishment therefor;  
and defines the nature of the various crimes; and prescribes the  
kind and measure of punishment to be inflicted for each. The manner  
of prosecuting and convicting criminals is regulated by the code of  
criminal procedure, Section 1 et seq. of Title 22 of the Oklahoma  
Statutes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
