AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY; AMENDING SECTION 7, CHAPTER 151, O.S.L. 1987 (63 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 1-1527), WHICH RELATES TO THE SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES ACT; PROVIDING FOR ENACTMENT OF MORE STRINGENT LAWS BY CITIES AND TOWNS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 151, O.S.L. 1987 (63 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 1-1527), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-1527. The State Legislature, by adopting ~~this act~~ the Smoking in Public Places Act, Section 1-1521 et seq. of this title, intends to preempt any other regulation promulgated to control smoking in public places and to standardize laws that governmental subdivisions may adopt to control smoking. Cities and towns may enact and enforce laws prohibiting and penalizing conduct under provisions of this act, ~~but the provisions of such laws shall be the same as provided in this act and the enforcement provisions under such laws shall not be~~ however, nothing in this act shall be construed to prohibit cities and towns from enacting and enforcing

provisions under laws that are more stringent than those of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
