AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CITIES AND TOWNS; PROHIBITING MUNICIPALITIES FROM CHARGING FEE OVER CERTAIN AMOUNT TO REGISTER CERTAIN STATE LICENSEES; MAKING FEES WHICH EXCEED SAID AMOUNT NULL AND VOID; CONSTRUING ACT TO NOT EFFECT PERMIT FEES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-106.1 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any municipality which requires persons licensed pursuant to the Plumbing License Law of 1955, Section 1001 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Electrical License Act, Section 1680 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the Mechanical Licensing Act, Section 1850.1 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to register prior to performing work within its jurisdiction shall not charge a registration fee for the initial year which exceeds the state licensing fee for the profession for a one-year period, nor a fee for each succeeding year which exceeds the state license annual renewal fee for the profession. Any existing or future registration fee charged to such licensees which exceeds the annual state licensing fee for the profession shall be

null and void. This section shall not be construed to restrict or void any fee charged for a permit issued by a municipality to such licensees.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
