AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; AMENDING SECTION 12, CHAPTER 345, O.S.L. 1985 (47 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 1114.2), WHICH RELATES TO MOTOR LICENSE AGENTS; AUTHORIZING MOTOR LICENSE AGENT TO MOVE OUTSIDE COUNTY IN WHICH AGENCY IS LOCATED AFTER CERTAIN TIME PERIOD WITHOUT FORFEITING APPOINTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 345, O.S.L. 1985 (47 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 1114.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1114.2 Any motor license agent appointed according to the provisions of Section 1140 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall have been a resident of the county in which his agency is located for a period of six (6) months prior to his appointment. Provided, that if not less than two (2) years after initial appointment, a motor license agent ~~moves~~ may move his residence to a place outside said county, ~~he shall forfeit~~ without forfeiting his appointment.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
