AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCE; AMENDING 62 O.S. 1981, SECTION 310.9, AS LAST AMENDED BY SECTION 2, CHAPTER 221, O.S.L. 1990 (62 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 310.9), WHICH RELATES TO INVOICES SUBMITTED TO CERTAIN POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS; CLARIFYING LANGUAGE; REPEALING SECTION 1, CHAPTER 305, O.S.L. 1990 (62 O.S. SUPP. 1990, SECTION 310.9), WHICH IS A DUPLICATE SECTION AND WHICH RELATES TO INVOICES SUBMITTED TO CERTAIN POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 1981, Section 310.9, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 221, O.S.L. 1990 (62 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 310.9), is amended to read as follows:

Section 310.9 A. On every invoice submitted to any county, municipality or school district, for payment ~~of~~ to an architect, contractor, engineer or supplier of materials of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) or more, the following sworn statement shall be signed:

The undersigned person, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, on oath says that this invoice is true and correct and that (s)he is authorized to submit the invoice pursuant to a contract or purchase order. Affiant further states that the (work, services or materials) as shown by this invoice have been (completed or supplied) in accordance with the plans, specifications, orders, requests or contract furnished or executed by the affiant. Affiant further states that (s)he has made no payment directly or indirectly to any elected official, officer or employee of the (county, municipality, school district) ~~or~~ of money or any other thing of value to obtain payment of the invoice or procure the contract or purchase order pursuant to which an invoice is submitted.

B. Any vendor of a school district which files an affidavit pursuant to subsection A of this section in any one fiscal year shall be exempt from filing any other affidavit pursuant to this section for any subsequent invoice to the same school district during the same fiscal year. Affidavits received shall be maintained by the school district in a vendor file and shall be a continuing affirmation by that vendor during the same fiscal year.

SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 1, Chapter 305, O.S.L. 1990 (62 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 310.9), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
