AS INTRODUCED

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES;  
STATING SUPPORT FOR CERTAIN STATE PLAN; RECOGNIZING AND  
PRAISING CERTAIN CITIZENS; AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the greatness of the State of Oklahoma is founded upon the spirit of its people and their commitment to ensuring the well-being of children, youth and families; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature, recognizing that responsibility for finding solutions to the problems confronting children, youth and families belongs to local communities, directed the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to work with the Oklahoma Planning and Coordinating Council for Services to Children and Youth and local concerned citizens and community organizations to design and implement a state plan for services to children, youth and families; and

WHEREAS, through this cooperative effort, the document "Children: Oklahoma's Gift to Tomorrow, A State Plan for Services to Children, Youth and Families, 1992-1995" was produced to provide a blueprint for legislative and administrative change relating to Oklahoma's children, youth and families. The plan will serve as the basis for program development and model site implementation for the next three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
OF THE 43RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate supports the goals and objectives  
contained in the document "Children: Oklahoma's Gift to Tomorrow, A  
State Plan for Services to Children, Youth and Families, 1992-1995."

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate hereby recognizes and praises the  
volunteer commitment and investment of time and resources of over  
one thousand Oklahoma citizens from communities across the state,  
who, out of their concern for children, have cooperated for the past  
year with the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth and the  
Oklahoma Planning and Coordinating Council for Services to Children  
and Youth to develop a means to achieve more comprehensive,  
coordinated services for children, youth and families.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma  
Commission on Children and Youth and the Oklahoma Planning and  
Coordinating Council for Services to Children and Youth.
