AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO CITIES AND TOWNS; AMENDING 11 O.S.
1981, SECTION 16-109, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 4,
CHAPTER 75, O.S.L. 1987 (11 O.S. SUPP. 1990,
SECTION 16-109), WHICH RELATES TO ELIGIBILITY OF
POLITICAL CANDIDATES; MODIFYING CERTAIN
REQUIREMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1981, Section 16-109, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 75, O.S.L. 1987 (11 O.S. Supp. 1990, Section 16-109), is amended to read as follows:

Section 16-109. To be eligible to become a candidate for a political party nomination in the municipality's primary election, a person must for at least six (6) ~~months~~ years prior to filing a declaration of candidacy be a registered voter at an address within the municipality or in the ward if an office is from a ward. To become a party candidate, a declaration of candidacy must be filed with the county election board no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on the first Monday in February and no later than 5:00 p.m. on the next succeeding Wednesday.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
