AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES; MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS
ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION; STATING THE PURPOSE;
PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF
EMPLOYEES; LIMITING THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR;
PROVIDING BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS; MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL DEFENSE;
STATING THE PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND
COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES; LIMITING THE SALARY OF
THE DIRECTOR; PROVIDING BUDGETARY LIMITATIONS;
PROVIDING LAPSE DATE; PROVIDING AN OPERATIVE DATE;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholic
Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission from any monies not otherwise
appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for

the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of _____ Dollars (\$_____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by law.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by law shall be set by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty-five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$45,994.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OFFICE OF CIVIL DEFENSE

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Civil Defense from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the amount of _____ Dollars

(\$_____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Civil Defense by law.

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Civil Defense by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Thirty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Two Dollars (\$38,202.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992. The Department of Civil Defense for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1992. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1992, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This act shall become operative July 1, 1991.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
