AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE BOARD OF VOCATIONAL AND  
TECHNICAL EDUCATION; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION  
THERE TO; STATING PURPOSE; AMENDING SECTION 138,  
CHAPTER 263, O.S.L. 1990, WHICH MAKES AN  
APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF VOCATIONAL AND  
TECHNICAL EDUCATION; MODIFYING APPROPRIATION  
FUNDING; MAKING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS NONFISCAL;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-six Dollars (\$372,886.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education and the

State Department of Vocational and Technical Education by law. The appropriation made by this section shall be transferred to the State Vocational-Technical Fund created pursuant to Section 14-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 138, Chapter 263, O.S.L. 1990, is amended to read as follows:

Section 138. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the ~~Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Cash-Flow Reserve~~ Fund of the State Treasury designated by the Office of State Finance as the "090" Fund, the sum of ~~Seven Million Six Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars~~ ~~(\$7,677,900.00)~~ One Million Eight Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-four Dollars (\$1,821,984.00) and from the Capital Preservation and Economic Enhancement Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Nine Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$5,855,916.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education and the State Department of Vocational and Technical Education by law and to accomplish the support of vocational and technical school activities as provided for in this act.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrances and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
