AN ACT RELATING TO VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES; MAKING  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS THERETO; STATING  
PURPOSES; PROVIDING LAPSE DATES; AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$\_\_\_\_\_) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses associated with the state's election administration system.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$\_\_\_\_\_) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$\_\_\_\_\_) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1991. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1991, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
