AS INTRODUCED

AN ACT RELATING TO TORTS; PROHIBITING ACTIONS FOR
PERSONAL INJURY CAUSED BY PRODUCTS OR PROFESSIONAL
SERVICES AFTER CERTAIN PERIOD; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 30 of Title 76, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No action in tort to recover damages shall be brought against
any person, firm, company, corporation, partnership, association or
other entity for personal injury caused by a product or professional
service which occurred more than two (2) years after one or more of
the following:

1. The date that the product was first purchased for use or
consumption; or

2. The date of the last professional action alleged to have caused the harm.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1991.
